YOU MUST REGISTER BY **OCTOBER 2ND** TO VOTE IN THE 2010 GENERAL ELECTION

REGISTER

- In person at your county voter registration office.
- At scVOTES.org, print an application, complete it and mail it to your county voter registration office.
- Mail-in applications must be postmarked by October 2nd.

MAKE SURE YOUR ADDRESS IS CURRENT BY OCTOBER 2ND

- Check your voter registration information online at scVOTES.org.
- Call or visit your county voter registration office.

EDUCATE YOURSELF ON THE CANDIDATES AND QUESTIONS

- Candidate lists and Constitutional amendment questions are available at scVOTES.org.
- Contact your county election commission for any local questions that may appear on your ballot.

VOTE

- If you are disabled, age 65 or older, or unable to go to the polls on Election Day; you may be eligible to vote by absentee ballot. Contact your county voter registration office. Ballots will be available by October 1st.
- On Election Day, bring your voter registration card, driver's license or DMV-issued ID card to your polling place.
- If you registered to vote by mail and are voting for the first time, you may have to show ID in addition to your voter registration card.
- Polls are open 7 a.m. - 7 p.m. November 2nd.
